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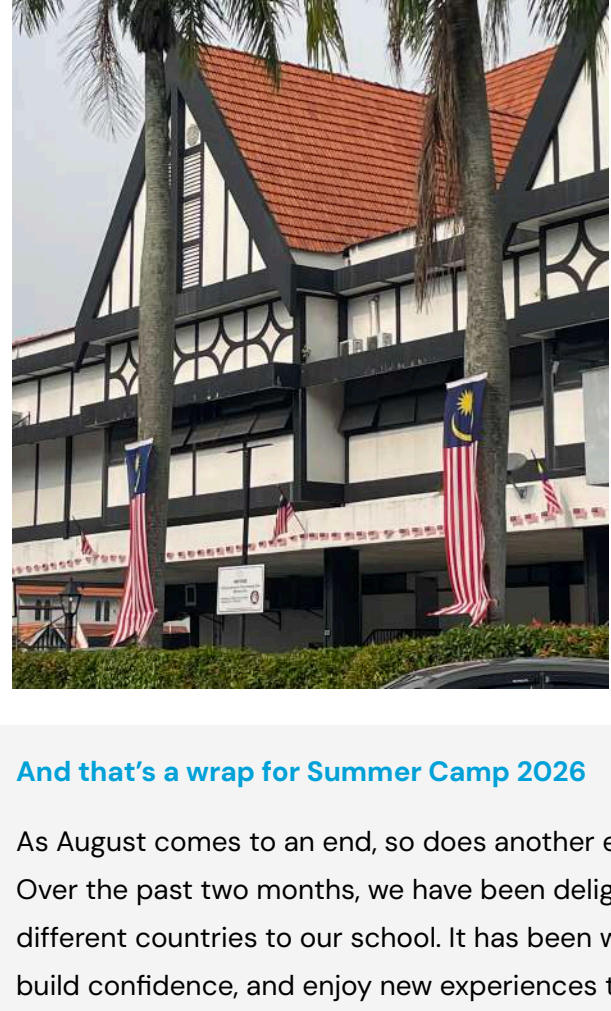
Happy Independence Day Malaysia!

As we look forward to the end of August, we celebrate a summer well spent and hope to welcome many of our campers back again soon! ☺☺

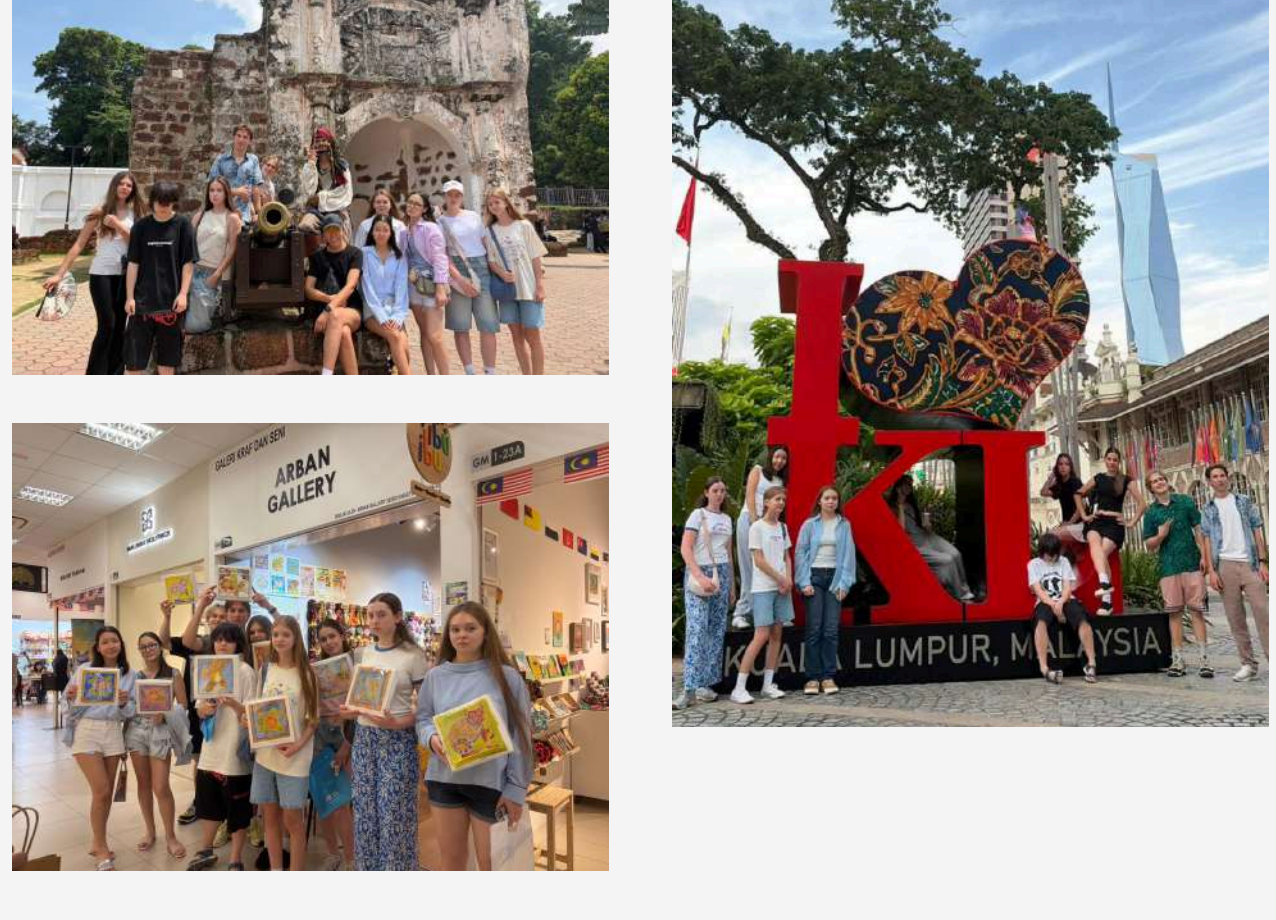
Highlights: Learning in Classrooms

Our Students' Activities

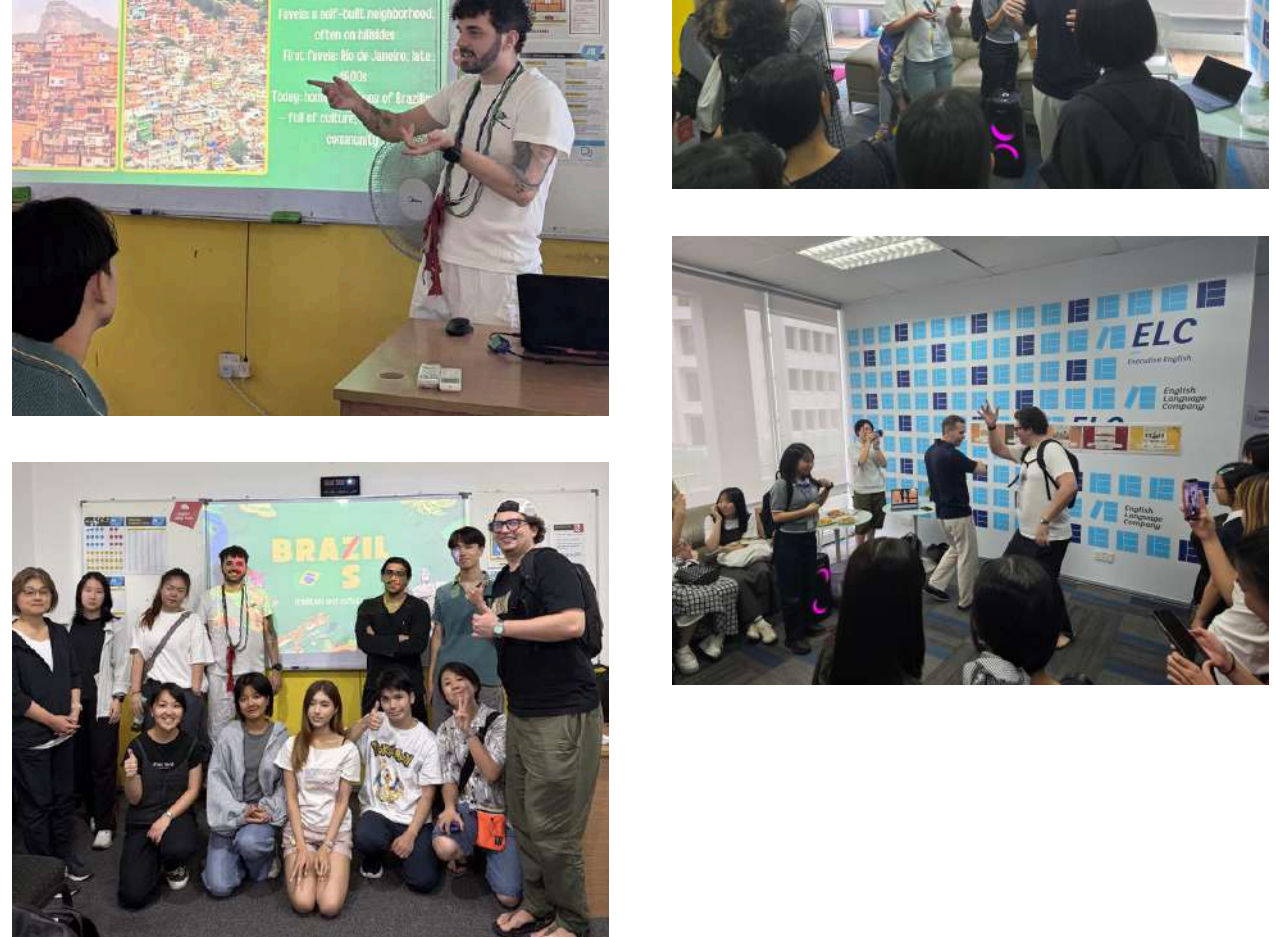

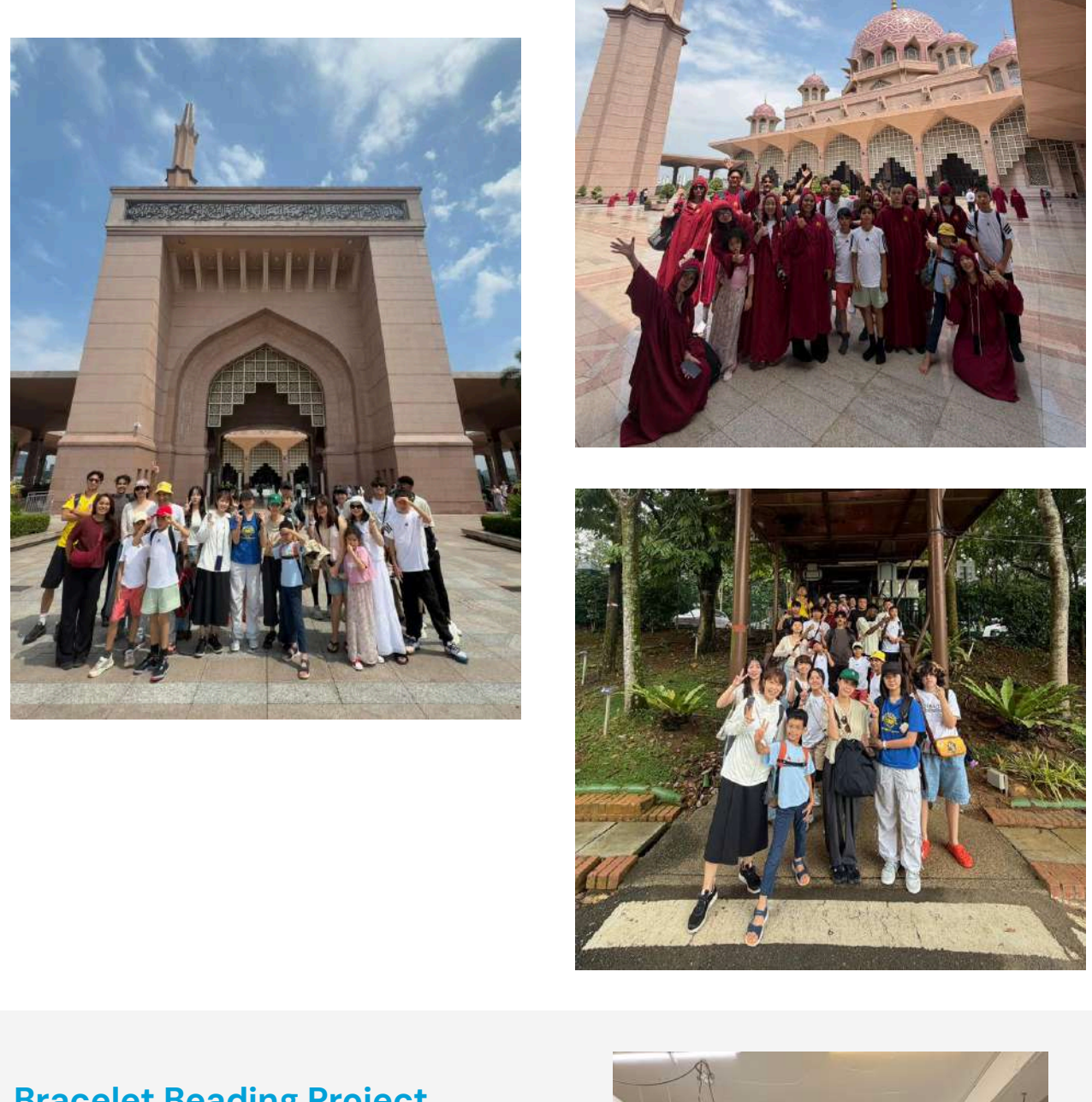
Middle Eastern Culture Day

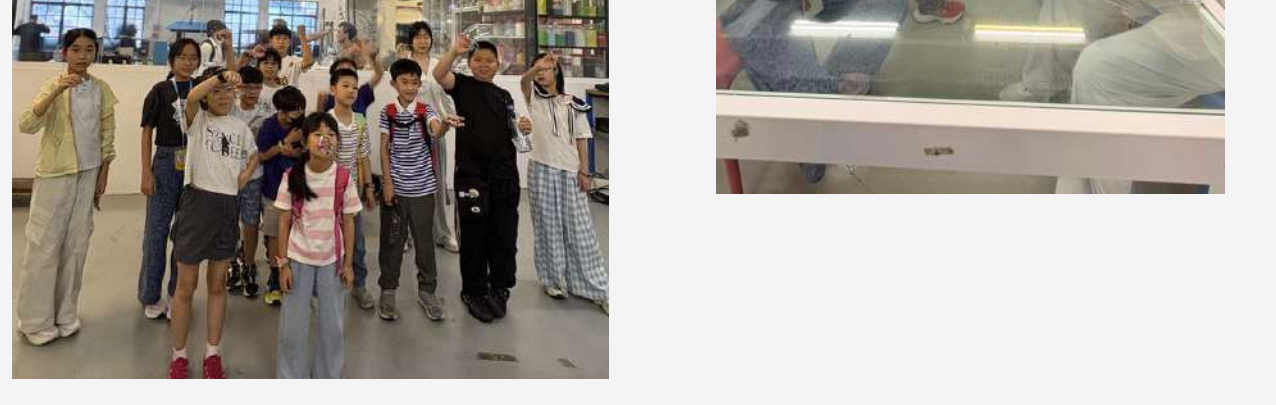
Exploring Putrajaya
